

## What You Need to Know

- Camp is for children ages 5-12 yrs old. Children MUST have completed K5 by Summer 2011.
- During camp, children are grouped according to their completed grade, K-2 and 3-6.
- Please pack a lunch and snack each day. Children may bring a drink, water is available.
- Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately, provide a sweater or smock if needed.

## Session 1: June 6 - June 10 HERE COMES THE SUN

Whether it's high in the sky or slowly setting over the horizon, the sun plays an integral part in each of our lives. In this camp session, we'll examine how artists use natural and artificial light in their art, and then we'll create a variety of fine art and fun projects that celebrate the sun, including pierced sun-catchers, sun prints, silhouettes and other lighting tricks in photography and so much more! In our performance segment of camp, we'll examine the various cultural myths of the sun's creation, learn the *Salutation of the Sun* in yoga and explore the use of light in creating shadow puppets.

## Session 2: June 13 - June 17 JUST ADD WATER

We're putting the WATER in watercolor for this session of camp! Using tempera, acrylic and watercolor, we'll paint portraits, landscapes and abstract images in this one-week session of camp. Through improvisation and creative movement, we'll also focus on water . . . how it moves, how it sounds and how it feels . . . for some entertaining and enlightening short skits.

## Session 3: June 20 - June 24 BLOWIN' IN THE WIND

There's no doubt that Corpus Christi is a windy city, and we're going to make the most of it in this session of art camp. From pinwheels and wind chimes to kites and paper airplanes, we're going to use our creativity to design art objects that utilize wind to function. On the performance side of camp, we'll explore music and movement and the role that air plays in both.

## Session 4: July 11 - July 22 WHEN NATURE CALLS

It's back to nature in this two-week camp session. Formerly our traditional clay and sculpture camp, we've expanded to include other art projects such as handmade paper and ephemeral (temporary) art. We'll even create pet rocks! In our drama segment of the day, we'll write, direct and star in a short play. \*This class is suited for beginner to intermediate clay artists and will emphasize hand-building techniques.

## Session 5: July 25 - August 5 GOING UNDERGROUND

*\*Advanced clay camp; ages 8 and up only*

You asked for it, you got it! New this summer is our 5th session of art camp especially geared for students who have experience in working with clay. The emphasis will be on fewer but more detailed projects as well as more time spent using the potter's wheel. Additional art projects will round out the last few days of camp to allow all day works to be fired. A short play will be written and performed by campers on the final day.
