



Session 1: June 3 - June 7

Hogwarts Americana

2-D / 3-D Projects and Creative Drama

Welcome to Hogwarts Americana - the American extension of Hogwarts! Campers will be immersed in the fictional world of Harry Potter through visual and performing art activities. They'll start off by being sorted into one of four houses: Embredor, Firesong, Grizzlestorm or Paladorn. Sculpture, Mixed Media and Improvisation

We're venturing into the wild in this rousing week of arts camp! Taking a cue from artist Kent Ullberg and his work in the *Celebrating the Wild and Wonderful* exhibition on view, we'll create 3-D versions of our favorite land and sea creatures using air-dry clay, papier mâché, and more. We'll also use our improvisation skills to create our own live version of *Animal Planet*! Location: AMST

Session 4: June 24 - June 28

COMIC AND CARTOON ART

Drawing and Creative Drama

Join us to explore the whimsical world of comic book and cartoon drawing! Taking inspiration from classic and popular culture, we'll draw several well-known cartoon and anime characters, superheroes and video game characters while focusing on exaggeration, action techniques, inking, coloring and more. In the creative drama portion of the day, we'll bring our characters to life! Location: AMST

FROM PAGE TO PAINTING

Painting and Reader's Theater

Join us as we bring the pages of our favorite books to life in this week-long session! We'll examine some of our favorite literary characters such as Harry Potter, the Cat in the Hat, Harold and his Purple Crayon, Fancy Nancy and so many more as we use watercolor and acrylic to paint imaginative portraits and narrative scenes. In drama, we'll see what happens when all these characters come together! Location: AMST

Back to the '80s!

Mixed Media and Music/Movement

It's all about the '80s in this camp session! We'll create tie-dye t-shirts, puff paint portraits, personalized buttons and more as we explore the art and music of this unforgettable decade! Location: AMST

The Clayground

Ceramics and Musical Performance

A highlight of each summer, clay camp packs a lot of punch in a short amount of time! In just two weeks, children will experiment with many hand-building techniques, glazing and even get a chance to try the pottery wheel. GOTTA CATCH 'EM ALL

Drawing, Mixed Media and Creative Drama

Inspired by the '90s hit animated series and collectible cards, we'll create some exciting Pokémon art! Illustrate and sculpt your favorite Pokémon character, participate with other trainers in a group art battle, and even develop a deck of Pokémon cards based on each camper's creations. Create new characters and bring them to life in the drama part of the day!

2-D & 3-D Art and Pantomime

Painting, Collage, 3-D Art and Music & Movement

Inspired by Kent Ullberg: *Celebrating the Wild and Wonderful* exhibition, we'll take a dive into the deep, mysterious blue. We'll experiment with different techniques in our seascape paintings, create our own diorama aquariums, create a photograph of an oceanic animal using a flashlight and much more! In the performance part of the day, we'll use music and movement to bring our favorite sea animals to life. Location: AMST
